Methodology

Crime is tracked for multiple years using both FBI aggregate crime reports and, for many parts of the country, at the individual incident level.

A complex set of statistical models are used to estimate and forecast risk of each individual crime type by using land use data in conjunction with demographic and business characteristics. Ethnicity, race, and language are not considered in the models.
